
#### Theme Rationale

Water, in its essence, carries deep philosophical meaning that resonates with people and with the spaces they inhabit. In the context of office breakout rooms and collaborative areas, it becomes a metaphor for connection, adaptability, and balance.


- Unity & Connection: All water eventually merges with other water. In the same way, people come together in these spaces to share ideas, collaborate, and support one another. The design nurtures this flow, encouraging interaction and teamwork.
- Fluidity & Adaptability: Water takes the shape of any form it enters, reminding us of the value of flexibility. These spaces, like water, adapt to people's needs, whether for collaboration, relaxation, or focused work, while also empowering individuals to remain authentic and comfortable.
- Strength in Softness: Though soft to the touch, water shapes landscapes with lasting impact. People, too, aspire to be gentle yet resilient, calm yet powerful. These spaces embody and encourage that duality, giving strength through comfort.
- Calmness & Focus: The calming presence of water mirrors the role of breakout spaces as places to reset. Whether stepping away to destress or finding focus in quiet, the environment provides balance, just as water balances energy in nature.
- Colour & Identity: Blue, the colour most associated with water, evokes serenity, imagination, loyalty, trust, and stability, values central to people and organisations alike. At the same time, water reflects all colours, symbolising inclusivity and adaptability. Similarly, these spaces can reflect diverse brand identities, moods, and goals, with the potential for customisable colour options that keep them timeless and versatile.






An initial exploration of ideas represented through freehand sketches, serving as a visual brain dump to capture a broad range of possibilities.







A process of refinement in which selected forms were systematically developed and evaluated, culminating in viable final outcomes, indicated by the blue highlights.











Out of the forms that were taken forward, these iterations were ultimately **excluded** from further development.







# **Final Product Concepts**

These represent the final product concept sketches, along with their respective sketching processes, presented at this stage. Each of them subsequently underwent design modifications in the following stages of development and production.













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**Note:** The leg design was refined from the initial version (left) to an improved iteration (right); additionally, the connector was detailed out and modified at a later stage.





# 4. Lounge Chair (Low-height) Note: This design was subsequently


















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
